

Photography Contest

THEME: The Heritage sites in and around Delhi University Campus

TERM

The 2015 WUS-DUC Photography Contest begins March 6, 2015 at 12:00:00 P.M. and ends March 22, 2014, 11:59:00 p.m. (IST). By submitting an entry, each entrant agrees to Rules and warrants that his or her entry complies with all requirements. This is a skill-based contest and chance plays no part in the determination of winners.

WHO MAY ENTER?

The contest is open only to individuals who are presently students of Delhi University. This contest is only for individual and not group.

HOW TO ENTER?

Each entry may consists of up to three images without any entry fee. Write (Your Name, Address, Contact Number, Name of College/Department, Course, Email Address, and Photo Caption; and submit by mail it in accordance with the instructions that follow.

RULES FOR SELECTION

- Individual entries need to be sent.
- An individual can send a maximum of three entries.
- Photos can be clicked using DSLRs, Digital Cameras and Smartphones and should contain the date and time info with a minimum resolution of 1600x900 pixels or greater. Images that do not meet this standard can still be judged, but may not be honored as a finalist in the competition.
- Submissions may be watermarked if desired, but the watermark should be inconspicuous enough to not interfere with the judging of the photo.
- Softcopies must be at least 1 Megabyte or maximum 10 Megabytes, Format of photographs must be in JPEG or JPG.
- Also send the EXIF details and location of pictures along with all your entries.
- Photographs must have been taken within two (2) years before the date of entry and may not previously have won an award any other Photo Contest.
- Post processing of any type isn't allowed. In-built Camera presets and filters can be used. Only basic editing (Lighting fixes, changes to hue/saturation) is allowed. Morphing, stitching pictures or using multiple pictures to create one image in any way or any changes to the original Photograph is unacceptable and will render the photograph ineligible for a prize.

- Photographs that include sculptures, statues, paintings, and other works of art will be accepted as long as they do not constitute copyright infringement or fraud.
- The photograph, in its entirety, must be a single work of original material taken by the Contest entrant. By entering the Contest, entrant represents, acknowledges, and warrants that the submitted photograph is an original work created solely by the entrant, that the photograph does not infringe on the copyrights, trademarks, moral rights, rights of privacy/publicity or intellectual property rights of any person or entity, and that no other party has any right, title, claim, or interest in the photograph.
- The caption must be complete and accurate, sufficient to convey the circumstances in which the photograph was taken. Disguising or misrepresenting the origin of your content is cause for disqualification.
- Clearly mention your name, email id, name of your college/department and contact number.

IMPORTANT

If the photograph contains any material or elements that are not owned by the entrant and/or which are subject to the rights of third parties, and/or if any persons appear in the photograph, the entrant is responsible for obtaining, prior to submission of the photograph, any and all releases and consents necessary to permit the exhibition and use of the photograph in the manner set forth in these Official Rules without additional compensation. If any person appearing in any photograph is under the age of majority in their state/province/territory of residence the signature of a parent or legal guardian is required on each release.
